The Yorkshire Philosophical Society

was formed in 1822, when "natural philosopher" was the term used for a scientist and, although the meaning of the word has changed in modern times, our traditional name has been retained.

From its earliest days the Society's main interests have been the natural sciences and antiquities, and one of its first achievements was to set up the Yorkshire Museum and its Botanical Gardens to promote the study of these subjects. Although the Museum and Gardens were put into Trusteeship in 1961, the Society maintains a close interest in them. Our office is situated in the former gatekeeper's lodge at the entrance to the Gardens, our lectures are held in the Tempest Anderson Hall, and members receive free admission to the Museum.

Today the YPS is a charitable organisation which continues to encourage interest in science and archaeology through grants and prizes, and in its annual series of public lectures. This runs from October to May, covering a wide variety of topics from the fields of science, archaeology, history and sociology, and includes lectures aimed specifically at a family audience.

The Society is affiliated to the British Science Association and acts as the branch centre for North and East Yorkshire.

The Society welcomes young and old to share its interests and participate in its educational and social activities.

In addition to our wide-ranging annual lecture programme (around 20 lectures from October to May), there are special events for members which take place roughly monthly and include
