24th June 8.15 am Leave York. Comfort stop at Hexham with time for refreshments (at own cost). Visit to "Floors Castle and Gardens". Lunch for the group, of soup and sandwiches, and an introductory talk with time to visit the Castle and Gardens. Short drive to the ruins of Kelso Abbey for brief stop before travelling on to the hotel in time to settle down before dinner. 25th June 9.15 am Drive to Melrose Abbey. English armies repeatedly ransacked Melrose Abbey, which was built by Cistercian monks from Yorkshire in 1136. Look out for the famous bagpipe playing pig. We continue to Abbotsford House and garden, the home of Sir Walter Scott. The garden he designed here is a rare example of a regency garden. An included light lunch at 1pm rounds off our visit here. We continue to Mellerstain House and Gardens and have time to explore them both. Private reception and talk at Traquair House this evening instead of dinner in the Hotel. Lady Catherine Maxwell Stuart will host this. Bar snacks at the hotel afterwards if requested (at own cost).

26th June Depart 9am Talk and tour of the Edinburgh Botanical Gardens. There is so much to discover and we have included a 90-minute tour with a guide who will introduce us to hidden treasures around the garden.
