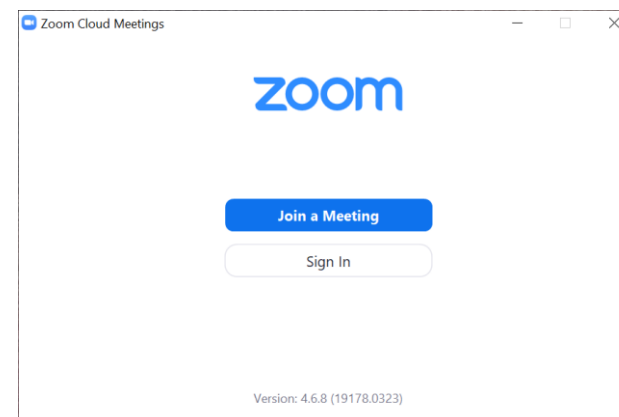
### Notes for Joining a Virtual Meeting using Zoom.

#### Set up

- Download Zoom to your PC, tablet or smartphone from <https://zoom.us/> and create a basic account.

#### To Join a Meeting

- The meeting organiser will send you an invitation by email to join a virtual meeting at a set date and time.
- Click on the link in the email. Zoom will open and you can click **Join a Meeting**



- When prompted, give Zoom access to your camera and microphone. If prompted about Audio, select **Computer Audio**.
- Don't have the camera facing a window as you will appear very dark on the screen. If this is your only option, close the curtains.
- Press on the **Video** icon if your video does not auto-start when you join the meeting.
- If you have problems, make sure your device is set up correctly i.e. your microphone and camera are switched on in your settings.

### Virtual Meeting Etiquette

- To avoid too much background noise, please mute your microphone when not speaking, using the setting in Zoom.
- Unmute your microphone when you wish to speak. Everyone in the virtual meeting will then hear what you say. Do give time for the chairman to reply as there may be a slight delay.
- For Lecture Q and A we may decide to ask for questions when you book a place.
- Please raise your hand to show the Chair you wish to speak if there is an opportunity to do so.
